- 4. Preference will be given to a student with a grade point average between 2.5 and 3.5

Required Information:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Resume to include (if any):
 - a. Work experience (nature of work, dates, employer)
 - b. Community service (nature of service, organization, dates)
 - c. Extracurricular activities (activity, grade levels, number of years)
- 3. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, community member, or employer
- 4. Current high school transcript

5. Essay of at least 250 words outlining your educational plans, career goals, financial need, challenges you have faced, how you have overcome adversity, and how this scholarship would make a difference in your life.

Selection Process -

One \$1500 scholarship for the school year will be awarded. A selection committee of the Aliene Anderson family will review each application and score based on quality of (narrative) responses and letters of recommendation.

Payment -

The scholarship will be paid directly to the Financial Aid Department of the college which the applicant has indicated he/she will attend. Half of the scholarship amount will be paid at the beginning of the fall The remaining half will be paid at the beginning of the spring upon enrollment verification by the school. Failure to maintain enrollment status will result in the cancellation of the scholarship and funds will be returned to the A.L.I.E.N.E. Scholarship Fund.
