WHAT YOUR CHILD HAS LEARNED

So far this year, we have

- > Changed chairs and moved quickly around the library in 90 second increments to explore different areas and talked about new book releases
- > Learned about the book challenge and how to search our collection's database
- ➤ Learned about Banned Books Week. We learned that we all like different things and if we all banned books we don't like, there aren't many to choose from.
- Learned about the Dewey Decimal system and which books are in the non-fiction section and where they are. This lesson will help them with testing.

We will be continuing to have booktalks, alternating with library/media center related lessons throughout the year.
